## College Bound

College Bound is the high school component of the Santa Fe summer program, aimed at helping our students thrive on a path to college. The program offers a two-week session (M-Th) for rising 9<sup>th</sup> grade students and one-week sessions for 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students. Three summer teachers, under the guidance of a mentor teacher, will teach age-appropriate college preparation, ACT prep, or writing and participate in activities such as college campus visits, team building, and career panels.

### College Bound teachers will:

- Teach two sections of either Critical Reading, Expository Writing, or ACT Science
- Participate in community building activities, college campus visits, panels, and other engaging college-prep related experiences
- Work on a committee, assisting with program-wide events like Celebration and Spirit Week

- Independent workers, resilient, and comfortable taking a leadership role
- Positive and flexible
